Finance Committee Update

The St. Rose Finance Committee was asked to provide a brief update halfway through our fiscal year. The December numbers are being finalized but as of the end of November we are doing okay. The Church is down a little on Sunday Collections and the expenses have also been kept below budget but still results in a slight deficit. The School finances have benefited from an approximately 15% increase in student enrollment this school year coupled with the expanded Indiana Choice Scholarship qualifications. This has increased the income year to date. Expenses are being closely watched by Principal Schroeder and the School is currently positive for the fiscal year to date. St. Rose also benefited from a grant that covered almost all of the cost of the new boiler in the School. If everything continues as it has the combined finances of St. Rose Church and School is expected to end the fiscal year on June 30, 2022 at a breakeven point or slightly positive.
